

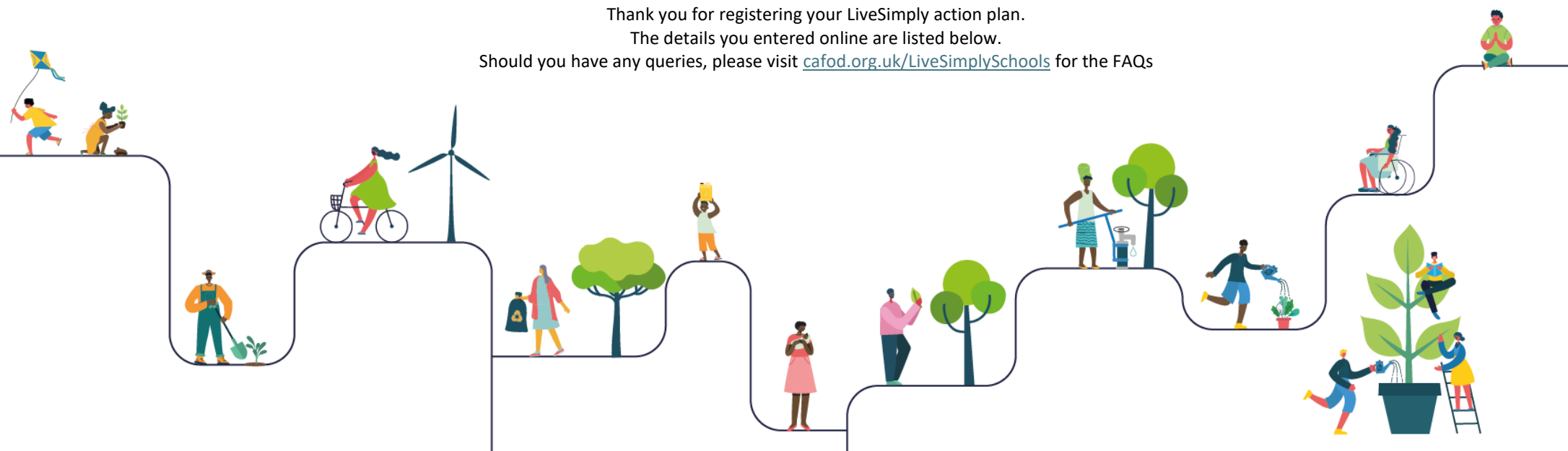

Global Actions

Action 1 *Living in Solidarity main action*

1A) ___ We will take part in the CAFOD Big Lent Walk. The whole school will take part in a sponsored walk to raise funds for, and awareness of, CAFOD's work in supporting our global family. (Living in Solidarity)

Global Faith element 1

Love your neighbour Jesus, friend and brother, You know what it is like to be hungry and thirsty. You know what it feels like to be a stranger who is made unwelcome. You know the suffering of all who have lost everything. We pray that by welcoming refugees we may show love for our neighbour and be closer to you. Amen.

'Love your neighbour as yourself.' Mark 12:31

By completing this challenge as a community, we will work together to raise money to help our global family.

Global Learning element 1

The children will learn to work as a team towards a shared goal. We will spend time learning about the communities that we can help and the impact of the fundraising can have.

How will you involve the wider community taking part in this action i.e. governors/families/parishioners/local people?

Children and staff will be invited to take part in the Big Lent Walk, with a similar opportunity shared with families to participate in at home.

Action 2

2B) ___ We will take part in climate justice campaign action to support our global family (e.g. contact politicians to ensure the world's poorest communities are at the centre of decision making on climate change, as they are the people most affected). (Living in Solidarity)

Global Faith element 2

Inspired by Laudato Si' we will think about how we can reduce, re-use & re-purpose, and finally recycle. We will create posters to encourage others in school and in our local community to make small changes to their daily routines to help combat climate change. Older year groups will write speeches and our Chaplaincy team will lead a whole school assembly.

Global Learning element 2

Children will learn that every action has a consequence and that we can make small changes to have a big impact.

We will use some of the CAFOD resources.

Action 3

3C) ___ We will take part in Refugee Week, raising awareness and spending time in prayer for our fellow brothers and sisters forced to flee their homes overseas. (Living Simply)

Global Faith element 3

John 15:12 'Love one another as I have loved you.'

Global Learning element 3

The children will learn what the refugee crisis is, why people have to leave their homes and how we can help these communities.

Local Actions

Action 1

1A) ____ We will create/maintain a link with a local care home, enabling our younger and older generations to share time together (e.g. talking, playing games such as dominos, learning more about the life of our older community, hearing top tips, singing to/with them, sending cards/letters). (Living Simply)

Local Faith element 1

Matthew 7:12 'Do to others as you would have done to yourself.' Pope Francis said, "Elderly people have so much to give us because there is the wisdom of life," He also urged Christians to bridge the gap between older and younger generations so that the elderly may pass on the "memory of life, the experience of life, the wisdom of life." "In the measure that we can help young people and old people connect, there will be more hope for the future of our society,"

Local Learning element 1

The children will learn about the importance of learning from the older generations and the importance of giving everyone your time. The children will also learn about the joy sharing time and events can bring to everyone.

Action 2

2A) ____ Inspired by Laudato Si' pupils will organise a litter pick in the community to protect wildlife and keep the local area tidy. Where possible, litter picked will be recycled appropriately. (You may wish to start your litter pick with a prayer.) (Living sustainably)

Local Faith element 2

Inspired by Laudato Si' we will organise termly litter picks in the local community and invite others to join us or collect litter when they can so our environment is safer for wildlife and more pleasant for residents.

Local Learning element 2

The children will learn what can be recycled and the importance of looking after our common home.

Pupils will watch CAFOD's Laudato Si' Animation.

We will say a prayer at the start of each litter pick ensuring we keep God's creation in our thoughts and minds and why it is important to care for people and planet.

Action 3

3B) ____ We will support our local foodbank. Pupils will be involved with organising, promoting, and checking the donations. Where possible we will visit a local foodbank or invite a representative to school to share more about their work. (Living in Solidarity)

Local Faith element 3

Catholic Social Teaching - Human Dignity, solidarity, option for the poor.

Local Learning element 3

We will support our local foodbank. Pupils will take the lead in regularly checking what items are needed and they will share this information with parents via our school newsletter.

Pupils will be involved in sorting the donations (checking the items are in date) and helping to deliver them to the foodbank. If possible, we will invite a representative from the food bank to come into school and speak with the children about the impact their donations will have.

School Actions

Action 1 – Living Simply main action

1B) ___ We will hold a whole school art or photography competition, celebrating awe and wonder of God's creations. Depending on the age group we will either provide quotations from scripture to inspire the pupils, or they will choose one themselves to go with their art/photo. (Living simply)

The creation story.

School Learning element 1

After hearing the creation story, pupils will work together to create prayers thanking God for his creation, they will spend time outdoors and draw plants and animals that God has created. The prayers and art work will be displayed in the school foyer, in classrooms, the school newsletter etc.

How will you involve the wider community taking part in this action i.e. governors/families/parishioners/local people?

We will invite the community to come in and enjoy the artwork and display them outside the school for passersby to enjoy too.

Action 3
