Re: Governors Fund

A very warm welcome to St Antony's Catholic Primary School – a happy school that we are immensely proud of. Your child has now been here for one term and I hope you are happy with the education and care your child is receiving.

At St Antony's, we place the person of Jesus Christ at the centre of all we do. We value the uniqueness of each individual and recognize that each of us has a special part to play in creating a better world and building up God's kingdom here on earth.

What is the Governors Fund?

All major improvements to the school that we undertake have to be covered by a 10% payment from the Governors Fund. For example, if we spent £80,000 improving your child's school the 10% i.e £8,000, has to be funded by the Governors from your generous donations to the fund. Without such kindness and generosity, the work would not take place.

A considerable amount of maintenance work was completed in the summer holidays and some significant upgrades to the water system and pipework has now begun. We have also installed all new playground equipment in our Nursery garden. I am sure you will all appreciate the importance of this necessary work; your child has the right to be educated in a safe environment.

If you already have a child at the school, hopefully you are already pledging money by personal internet banking for which we thank you. For new families the Governing Body ask for a donation by personal internet bank transfer once a month of £6, or one off yearly payment of £70; this covers your family and is not per child.

If all parents committed to making this contribution, we could raise approximately £18,660 across the school, this is a significant amount, to enable capital works to take place.

We thank you in advance for your generous donations. If you could please either set up a regular personal internet banking transfer via your bank or make a payment via [your scopay account](#). Just a small thought - £5 per month may not be much in money terms but the collective good it will do when we all work together will have a great impact on the school community.
